Care at Home. Medically fragile children enrolled in the Care at Home waiver can be eligible for Medicaid based on the child's income and assets with the parents' income waived. This covers service coordination, environmental modifications and adaptive technology not usually paid for by Medicaid. The Comprehensive Primary Care Plus (CPC+) program is a Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) five-year (2017 to 2021) payment and care delivery model. Over 440 primary care practices in Michigan were selected to participate in the program. As per CMS, no additional practices will be added to the demonstration.
